

SERVICES CONTRACT

On the one hand, Ms. Judit Carrera Escudé, General Director of the **CENTRE DE CULTURA CONTEMPORÀNIA DE BARCELONA (CCCB)**, with registered office at Calle Montalegre, No. 5, Barcelona (08001) and NIF P-5800017-E, on behalf of and representing the same, in the use of the powers attributed to her by virtue of the Statutes of this Consortium.

And on the other hand, Mrs. **PATRICIA MARIA SUSANAH CHANCO EVANGELISTA**, with passport number _____, acting on her own behalf, with registered office in Philippines,

ADMINISTRATIVE BACKGROUND

First. - The contracting file, processed according the ordinary proceeding, through a negotiated procedure without publicity, of the advisory and curatorship service within the framework of the 2nd International Residences Program, and authorization for the temporary use of the appartement located at Av Diagonal No. 365 in Barcelona (Exp. CCCB/2025/0006445), was approved by Decree of the General Director of this entity.

Second. - The maximum expenditure arising from this contract for an amount of €18,000.00, excluding VAT, will be charged to budget application 1.33412.22712 of the CCCB expenditure budgets for the year 2025.

In view of this background, the parties mutually recognize their competence and capacity to formalize this contract, in accordance with the following:

CONTRACT CLAUSES

First.- The General Director of the CCCB, formalizes in favor of Mrs. Patricia Maria Susanah Chanco Evangelista with passport _____ of the Republic of Philippines, this contract relating to the advisory and curatorship service within the framework of the 2nd International Residences Program, and authorization for the temporary use of the dwelling located at Av Diagonal No. 365 in Barcelona, subject to the technical specifications and other attached documentation, contractual documents that Mrs Evangelista fully accepts and of which she leaves proof by signing hereby her agreement to each of them (Annex).

Second. - The obligations of Mrs. Evangelista, listed in the technical specifications, mainly in clauses 2 and 3, are, among others, the following:

1st phase:

- Two online meetings to prepare the content and framework of the residency.
- Two advisory meetings to the CCCB teams regarding new voices in international journalism from non-Western geographies and, mainly, from Southeast Asia.
- Conceptualization of a cycle of public conversations around the languages of contemporary dictatorships.
- Proposal of possible lecturers, contact and confirmation of their participation.
- Writing of the texts that describe and accompany the cycle.
- Conceptualization of a master class session around literary creation and research in the field of non-fiction.
- Conceptualization of a master class session on new investigative journalism, focused on specialization in contexts of conflict and violence.

2nd phase:

- Inaugural press conference, interviews and first phase of meetings with the press.
- Drafting and public reading of the inaugural conference.
- Conducting the two public conversations with the cycle guests, which will be included in a publication.
- Conference for high school students in the framework of the "Un matí amb" program.
- Participation in the educational and community project "Escola en Residencia"
- In-depth interview for the development of teaching materials by the Open University of Catalonia (UOC)
- Interview for the audiovisual project "Entrevista CCCB".
- Participation in the interdisciplinary seminar "Les paraules de la dictadura".
- Meeting with journalists and media managers of the city.
- Meeting with students of journalism, documentary, creative writing.

3rd phase:

- Meeting with readers in the Laie and Backstory bookstore.
- Meeting with agents and organizations for the defense of human rights.
- Meetings with agents of the Filipino community in the city of Barcelona.
- Meetings with different research groups from Catalan public universities experts in Asian studies.
- Second phase of interviews and meetings with the press.
- Open Classroom for CCCB teams.

The contract includes also all necessary working meetings with the CCCB's project preparation team.

Third. - Accommodation

In order to carry out the advisory and curating work, subject of this contract, the CCCB will make available to the resident the dwelling located in Barcelona on Avenida Diagonal, 4th floor, 2nd, as described in the Technical Specifications Document attached to this contract.

Fourth. - The contract price is €18,000, VAT excluded.

The contractor will submit an invoice at the end of each of the phases of execution of the works established in the Technical Specifications Document that governs the contract.

Payment will be made by the CCCB, subject to prior consent from the Department of Mediation of the CCCB, within the time limits established in article 198.4 LCSP.

Public limited companies, limited liability companies and other entities included in article 4 of Law 25/2013, of December 27, on the promotion of electronic invoicing and the creation of the accounting register of invoices in the public sector, will have to submit electronic invoices in accordance with current regulations.

The following DIR3 codes must be included in all electronic invoices:

Accounting office (role 01) LA0006837
Managing body (role 02) LA0006837
Processing unit (role 03) LA0006837

Fifth. - The contract will be valid from the date of its formalization and until the completion of the contracted works, scheduled for July 30th, 2025.

Sixth. - The contractor agrees with the Specific Administrative Clauses Document that governs this contract, signing a copy of the same that is attached as an Annex, and submits, for everything that is not found in the aforementioned established document, to the pertinent rules of the contractual order in public administrations.

Seventh. - The parties undertake to treat, during and after the validity of this contract, all information known by virtue of its execution, as well as information provided to each other, in a strictly confidential manner, using it solely and exclusively for the purposes expressed in this contract, and adopting the necessary measures to prevent its knowledge by third parties.

Eighth. - All issues that may arise from the modification, termination, interpretation and compliance of this contract shall be resolved by the contracting body. The agreements may be appealed before the courts of Barcelona corresponding to the contentious-administrative jurisdiction, with express waiver by the contractor of any other jurisdiction or court that may correspond to it.

And for the record, the parties sign this contract, in Barcelona, on the date indicated in the respective digital signatures.
